Subcommittee of the Action Committee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Defined by AC 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No limitation on number of AC members 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Defined by AC 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Subject to Sunshine Law: notice, agenda, open meetings, testimony, minutes
CDP Community Partner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Defined by group 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Up to 2 AC representatives who act as liaisons between community partner and AC 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Defined by group 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not subject to Sunshine Law; can present reports to AC as long as item is agendized; no minimum or max meeting requirement; if <u>appropriately</u> agendized, AC could vote on issue in 1 mtg.
